INSTRUCTIONS:

3. PPT- Students must bring the prepared presentation on a given topic and will be provided 3 minutes for explanation and two minutes for question-answer rounds. The best group will be chosen from each class, and the final inter-class round will be arranged in the auditorium during the 4th and 5th periods on Thursday, September 14, 2023

4. Working model- In a group of 6, students must present their working model on any suitable science-based topic. The best group will be selected from each section by the judges.
