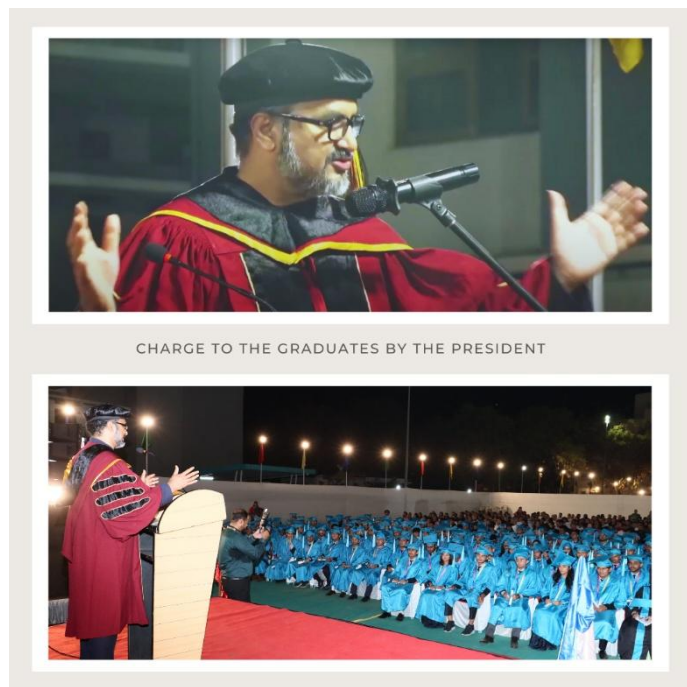


## Inauguration of Annual Magazine – "Crescent"
