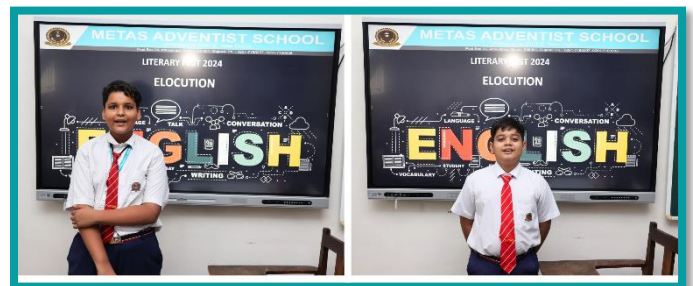


into the depth of knowledge and creativity these young minds possess.
